

ILP (Individualized Learning Plan) Group Offerings- April - June 2008

The following ILP groups will be offered during the eight-week cycle from April 23, 2008 to June 11, 2008. All ILP groups will meet each Wednesday afternoon from 1:50-2:50 pm.

Board Games

For K Only

The students will work together in small groups to focus on social skills through modeling, discussion, role play, and encouragement in board games. The focus of board game play will be initiating conversation, turn taking, discussing feelings, appropriate interactions, etc.

Canvas Creations

For Grades 2-6

The end product from this ILP group will be an artistic creation created with embroidery floss and plastic canvas. Students will learn technique of "cross stitch" on plastic canvas. They will design and plan a picture, then color their canvas to create a blueprint of their design. They will then fill it in with embroidery floss. Finished projects will be displayed in the school and will be brought home!

Dinosaur Exhibit

For Grades K, 1, 2

Explore the age of dinosaurs with books, magazines, and movies. Activities will include the construction of a shadow box, dino inventions, volcanoes, and journal writing. The ILP will culminate with a visit to the Dino Museum in Montville, CT!

Computer Programming

For Grades 4-6

This ILP Group will introduce computer programming and web page creation. Students will create web pages the HTML computer language. They will create graphics for the web using Photoshop. They will post their pages live on the Internet.

Fun Crafts with Food

For Grades 1, 2, 3

Students will be creating pieces of artwork that incorporate food as part of the materials. They will participate in activities such as vegetable stamping, edible necklaces, and dried apple faces. Each week, students will have a completed project to take home.

Karate

For Grades 1-6

Representatives from Ichiban Karate Studio in Wakefield will instruct students in the basic maneuvers and discipline of martial arts.

Ladies Volleyball

For Grade 4, 5, & 6 Girls

The girls will continue to learn new volleyball skills and improve the elements of the game they have learned in PE. The girls will also learn teamwork skills and sportsmanship.

Moviemaking

For Grades 4-6

Students will learn basic terminology of film, collaborate on a script, and produce a short fiction film. The final exhibition will consist of showing the DVD of our movie.

Native American Studies**For All Grades**

In this ILP group students will learn cultural differences in Native American tribes. Students will be introduced to types of dance, regalia, and jewelry. Students will learn the differences of how Native American tribes live today in comparison to the past. Activities include the creation of wampum jewelry and a visit by a Native American storyteller.

Poetry Party**For Grades K & 1**

In this ILP group we will have fun with poems by working with rhymes, name poems, comparisons, shape poems, and more... Cheerios and candy included!

Sculpture**For All Grades**

In this ILP group we will create a group-designed, large sculpture for the garden, all while learning about form and armature building, and the process of plaster. Students will also create small individual sculptures in clay and plaster.

Soccer**For Grades 4-6**

This ILP group will instruct students in basic soccer skills, sportsmanship, and teamwork. It will feature 6 on 6 tournaments.
